The Museum for Communication Berlin unites the past, present and future under one roof. Its permanent exhibition offers vivid insights into the origins, development and future of the information society. A series of attractive temporary exhibitions showcases the many different aspects of communication.

The heart of the building is the light-flooded central atrium surrounded by a series of galleries. At night, light is emitted through the atrium roof so that the museum resembles a blue crystal – creating a fascinating landmark in Berlin's cityscape.

The museum's Treasure Chamber displays a collection of valuable rarities, including the famous Blue and Red Mauritius. This website also contains details on the museum's history and architecture.

The historic architecture and magnificent atrium offer a unique setting for evening gala dinners, receptions and concerts, lectures, conferences and press conferences

The Museum for Communication Berlin was opened in 1898 as the Imperial Postal Museum (Reichspostmuseum), making it the world's oldest postal museum. This impressive, richly ornamented building has been fully restored and modernised.










